Year 11 Art Trip - Tate Modern

We have arranged an exciting opportunity for our Year 11 Art students for the beginning of next term. This visit will offer our students a wonderful opportunity beyond the classroom and further enrich their educational experience.

On Wednesday 10th January 2024 we will be visiting Tate Modern to see 'Capturing the Moment' exhibition. Among other famous artworks in the exhibition, we will have an opportunity to see 'Woman Weeping' by Picasso, which we have studied in class.

We will leave school in the morning and travel to Tate Modern by tube. We will aim to be back by the end of the school day (around 3:15pm).

This is an essential trip for Art GCSE and all students are expected to attend. If your family has any issues with making the payment, we have a small amount available to support you with them - please speak to Mrs Mustafa if this affects you.
